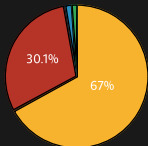

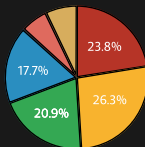

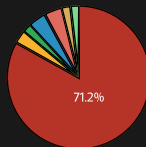

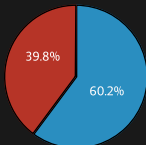

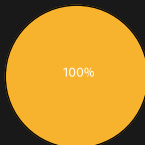


Fig. 1 - GENDER

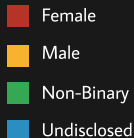


Fig. 2 - YEAR

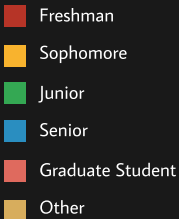


Fig. 3 - MAJORS

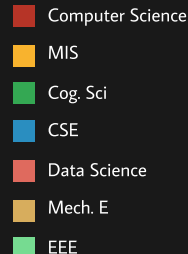


Fig. 4 - 1ST TIME HACKER?

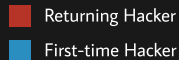


Fig. 5 - FUN HAD

PRE + POST EVENTS

Pre- and Post- events are an addition to the sponsorship perks for UGAHacks 9. They allow for our sponsors to create closer connections to UGA students by meeting them in a smaller group setting at our sister computer science organizations on campus. This allows for companies to create a bond with our students before the event or further a relationship created at the event, which allows for a more personal hackathon experience for both the companies and students. Past pre/post events have been mini challenges, introductions to recruitment opportunities, panels, and networking. WORKSHOPS + SIDE EVENTS

We're proud to continue offering side events and workshops to corporate sponsors! At their core, side events are meant to be fun, social events sponsors can put on to increase interaction with attendees and garner interest in their company. These events, generally around 45 minutes, help create a memorable experience for the hackers and help recruitment and marketing efforts of companies.

Workshops have a more technical focus, allowing a sponsor to show off an API or skill-set that they see as particularly useful. These workshops include a teaching and interactive element which will allow hackers to apply their new skills in projects or sponsor challenges.
